

Pray that he would develop a fear of the Lord. (Proverbs 1:7)

Beg God to draw him near to Himself; that if he isn't a believer in Jesus Christ, that he would heed the Holy Spirit's conviction, repenting, and placing his faith in Christ for salvation. (2 Peter 3:9; John 3:16)

Ask God to grant him a love for the Bible and for prayer. (Psalm 119:97; Colossians 4:2)

Pray for an awareness that he is in office by God's allowance, and that he therefore holds a sacred responsibility. (Daniel 2:21; Romans 13:1)

Ask that he would be surrounded by wise counselors. (Proverbs 20:18)

Ask that he would lead our country in a way that encourages and enables its citizens to find the fulfillment of honest labor. (Proverbs 13:4; 2 Thessalonians 3:10-12) Pray that he would develop a heart for God's glory to be made known in our country. (Psalm 96:3)

Ask God to help him make wise decisions, that God's will might be fulfilled in our nation. (Psalm 32:8; Matthew 6:10)

Pray that in all things, personal and official, he would hate what is evil and cling to what is good. (Romans 12:9)

Entreat God to move his heart to make God-honoring decisions based on truth, particularly in the areas of abortion, marriage, and protection of parental and religious freedoms. (I Corinthians 10:31)

Pray that his family life would be strong, protected from the stresses and temptations he faces. (Ephesians 5:25; Ephesians 6:4)

Ask that God would prompt more of His people to honor our President and to pray for him. (I Peter 2:17; I Timothy 2:1-2)
